Introduction

1) The Praesidium leads the cantus. 2) The Senior is the highest power of the cantus 3) The people walking around are the Co-Seniors 4) The Corona consists of all the people participating (you). 5) By joining the Beercantus, you obey the rules, which are set by the Praesidium.

The Rules

6) You are NOT allowed to drink, speak or walk around unless the head of the Praesidium (Senior) says so. This means that you are not allowed to drink, speak or walk around during the songs or any time at all the senior says so.

7) You are NOT allowed to have your booklet open while NOT singing. So only during the songs you can use your booklets.

8) Before you start to drink, you have to say *cheers!*

The Senior will call out: "*Prosit Corona!*"

The Corona responds with: "*Prosit Senior, Prosit Co-senior, Prosit Corona!*"

After which the Senior will tell you the drink commando.

9) There are three types of drink commandos:

- *Ad Fundum* - You have to drink the total amount of beer that is in your glass at once.
- *Ad Satis* - You drink until the Senior says "Satis" (stop).
- *Ad Libitum* - You drink as much or as little as you want.

10) If you do not obey these rules, the Praesidium can punish you:

The person that is not obeying the rules of the Praesidium can be called to the Praesidium table. Then you have to do whatever the Praesidium tells you to do.

11) While singing a song, everyone has to stand up.

12) When you want to go to the bathroom, you must recite a four-line rhyme. To be allowed to recite this rhyme, you must first ask the Senior for permission to speak.
